MINUTES OF MEETING January 12, 2010

SAM'S PIZZA @ 2:00PM

Members present: Dave & Vesta Pitt, Dave Boddy, Frank Ryan, Carol Haberstich, Gerald Hayler, Art Domingos, John Caudle, Jim Araiza, Minta & Will & Little Will Leslie, Phillip Padilla, Jim Blakeman, Owen & June Plummer and Ken Nachman.

Meeting called to order by President Dave Pitt at 12:20 pm.

A motion to accept the December minutes was made by Art Domingos, seconded by Dave Boddy. A motion to accept the December treasurers report was made by Frank Ryan and seconded by Carol Haberstich – both passed.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Gerald Hayler presented the correspondence to HCR&PC:

New member applications – Louie Escalante of Fall River Mills and Tom Ghiorso of Burney. The motion for approval was made by Art Domingos, seconded by Jim Caudle and passed.

Billing from Packway materials for range improvements including road work and safety wall were presented for a total of \$6401.25. The bill was paid.

An offer from the NRA to renew Gold Medal Club membership was presented. The renewal will be submitted by Gerald Hayler.

Letters were received from Sheriff Tom Bosinco and the State Parks and recreation thanking us for waiving range fees for law enforcement and active military personnel.

DISCIPLINE CHAIRPERSON REPORTS:

CLA Silhouette – Carol Haberstich reported that the first day of shooting this year collected fees for 19 smallbore rifle and 1 hunter pistol.

Black Powder Cartridge – Art Domingos reported that there has not yet been a .22 long range match.

SASS Cowboy Action – Jim Caudle is the new match director.

IHMSA – Dave Pitt says that no matches have been held yet. If anyone wishes to try out silhouette shooting with a pistol from the Creedmore position, please contact him and give it a try!

Military and High Power Silhouette – Phillip Padilla is the new match director and will see about scheduling some matches.

OLD BUSINESS:

Dave Pitt – Range improvements for the 200 meter line adjustment to accommodate the inability to see the rams when in the creedmore position. Dave wants to get all involved members together and determine the required height for stand modifications.

Dave Pitt – Range lease status. Dave was informed that we have not had any response to the request for a new lease. After discussion it was proposed that in March we pay our range rent up front for a 10 year period, thus enabling us to apply for grants from the Friends of the NRA. Cashing the check for the range rent should constitute a lease agreement. A motion to do so was made by Owen Plummer and seconded by Jim Blakeman. The motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Owen Plummer requested information about the duties of the groundskeeper and the scheduling of work parties.

Carol Haberstich discussed the request by James Sehurt for handicapped accommodations after getting his wheelchair stuck in the cinders in front of the high power line while trying to negotiate the step in the platform. Dave Pitt and Owen Plummer will make the arrangements. They would like member Sehurt to meet them at the range and determine what will be the best approach to meet his needs.

Carol Haberstich relayed the request from Cliff Carpenter for two new member applications and an additional shooting schedule because two of his coworkers are interested in joining the club.

Carol Haberstich requested a pin buyback at \$0.50 per pin. The pins should be returned to Gerald Hayler who will provide the payment for them.

Frank Ryan – The Bill Haberstich Memorial CLA Silhouette match has been approved as an NRA Registered Regional Match. Frank is the Match Director and the match is scheduled for June 4,5,6 2010. Friday June 4 starting at 8:30am will be two 40 shot Smallbore matches with the aggregate scores constituting the 3rd match. Saturday starting at 8:30am will be two 40 shot Pistol Cartridge matches with the aggregate scores constituting the 3rd match. On Sunday starting at 11:00am will be the single big-bore rifle match of 60 shots. The starting time allows the sun to reach an optimum position for lighting the targets. Flyers will be sent to clubs in the adjacent states and Idaho. The matches will be limited to 40 shooters and 8 setters will be needed for each match. There will be a Cowboy Action shooting demonstration on Sunday morning.

It was noted that there should be an expression of thanks to the donations for the door prizes at the Annual Dinner meeting. Those thanks should go to Dave Pitt and The Great Outdoors. A motion was made to adjourn by Carol and seconded by Will. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 1:13pm.

- (a) The officers of this Club shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Executive Officer, ~~Statistical Officer~~, Range Officer and Range Groundskeeper who, acting together, constitutes the Board of Directors. They shall be elected by majority vote of the members present at the Annual Meeting of the Club. Their term of office shall be for one (1) year or until such time as new Officers can be elected except as noted in Article VI, paragraph (h) (i).

Article VII - Duties of Officers

- ~~(g) The Statistical Officer shall maintain the statistical records of scores shot in Club matches and submit an annual report. He/she shall perform the duties outlined in NRA Silhouette Rules regarding the Statistical Officer. The Statistical Officer shall post shooter classifications Quarterly on the bulletin board.~~
