MINUTES OF MEETING September 13, 2009

Sam's Pizza

Members present: Gerald Hayler, Dave Boddy, Peter Brown, Carol Haberstich, Frank Ryan, Mike Milington, Lois and Ron Balint. Gerald had received a proxy vote from Dave Bowers.

Meeting called to order by Frank Ryan at 2:00pm.

The August 2009 minutes were approved after a motion by Dave Boddy, seconded by Peter Brown

The August 2009 treasurers report was approved after a motion by Carol Haberstich, seconded by Dave Boddy.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Gerald Hayler presented the correspondence to HCR&PC:

New member applications:

Laura Barrett of Fall River Mills, Richard Farley of Auburn, James Anderson of Redding and Gerald Nelson of Round Mountain; the motion to approve was made by Peter Brown, seconded by Dave Boddy and passed.

DISCIPLINE CHAIRPERSON REPORTS:

Cowboy Action – Dave Boddy reported that there were 9 shooters for the Saturday September 12 match. Dave also announced that there would be a work party on October 6 to prepare the ground for the new storage container. New bids should be requested for the desired 40 foot long container in the current economic environment.

Lever Action – Pistol Cartridge – Carol Haberstich reported that there were only 4 shooters for the first match on Saturday September 12 and that the second match of that day was cancelled. The match of September 13 had 6 shooters.

Grounds Keeper – Peter Brown reported that the range was in good shape.

Old Business:

Frank led the discussion about the Stewardship Council and the future land ownership. There appear to be three types of ownership that we could pursue:

1. Fee Title Owner
2. Conservation District
3. Conservation District Partner.

Our type of nonprofit corporation does not qualify us to be a Fee Title Owner and the small size of the tract of land that we are interested in is too small for a conservation district. The third option would require us to find an organization to partner with. One possibility might be to partner with the Fall River Mills Conservation District.

Eric Kurihara is the match director for two remaining Saturday CLA Pistol matches and has conflicts with his work schedule. Gerald Hayler volunteered to be the match director for those matches.

The NRA High Power Silhouette match scheduled for September 27 is cancelled as the majority of regular shooters are unable to attend.

Military matches are cancelled for the rest of the year due to minimal attendance.

Gerald was directed to see that the match cancellations are included in the HCR&PC website.

New Business:

It is time to survey the Discipline Chairmen for their input in 2010 scheduling.

Dave Boddy said that we need to refresh porta-potties that have become dry with 2 gallons of water prior to use.

Gerald Hayler should work with Dave Bowers to request a 20 year lease agreement with PG&E

The Annual Dinner meeting is scheduled for November 14. The dinner will be a pot luck with the club supplying the main entrée. Mike Redman has offered to cook the entrees. A letter should be sent to the members to determine:

1. How many will attend and what choice of club supplied entrée
2. A call for volunteer to setup and tear down at the dinner
3. A call for nominations for elected board members, most of which are to be vacant and must be filled to keep the club in existence.

Frank Ryan provided a copy of the CRPA rules for Muzzle Loader Matches and requested that they be included in the Newsletter. Gerald was requested to forward a copy to Duane Wieden. There was discussion about what Duane Wieden would need to accomplish to host a State Championship match in 2010.

Discussion of the Bill Haberstich Memorial match in 2010 centered on it being an NRA Regional match or a club sponsored match. Possible dates are 25, 26 and 27 on June.

The Cowboy Action "Ambush" is planned for the third weekend in June.

Dave Boddy requested information in support of Lowell Fletcher and his air rifle requirements for the Venture Scout troop marksmanship program.

Peter Brown suggested that the rise in front of the 200 meter ram line be cut down to increase visibility. Discussion led to the decision that raising the target stands and the ground level at the stands would be easier.

The 2010 dues are to be \$50 plus the \$25 for those who did not participate in work parties and were not excluded by virtue of living more than 100 miles from the range or having a medical excuse. Membership renewal forms should be sent out in October. Law Enforcement officers are to have free access to the range

The meeting was adjourned at 3:36 pm.

We are writing to inform you of pending legislation that will restrict purchases of handgun ammunition in California and will terminate our ability to service your needs for certain products.

On Friday, Sept. 11, the California Assembly passed Assembly Bill 962, by a 44-31 vote.

Among other regulations, AB 962 would:

- Ban all mail-order and Internet sales of handgun ammunition.
- Prohibit the retail sale, the offer for sale or the display of handgun ammunition in a manner that allows ammunition to be accessible to a purchaser without assistance of a vendor or employee.
- Require that the delivery or transfer of ownership of handgun ammunition occur in a face-to-face transaction, with the deliverer or transferor being provided bona fide evidence of identity of the purchaser or other transferee.

That evidence of identity, which must be legibly recorded at the time of delivery, includes:

- The right thumbprint of the purchaser or transferee.
- The date of the sale or other transaction.
- The purchaser's or transferee's driver's license or other identification number and the state in which it was issued.
- The brand, type and amount of ammunition sold or otherwise transferred.
- The purchaser's or transferee's signature.
- The name of the salesperson who processed the sale or other transaction.
- The purchaser's or transferee's full residential address and telephone number.
- The purchaser's or transferee's date of birth.

The bill is on the desk of Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger, where it awaits his consideration. He will have until Oct. 11 to sign or veto the bill. If he does not veto the bill, it will become law.

We encourage all Cabela's customers who participate in the shooting sports to contact Gov. Schwarzenegger to voice their opposition to this initiative, which will limit your opportunities to shop with Cabela's, and will restrict the sale of handgun ammunition everywhere in California.

FYI

AB 962 (De Leon) Ammunition – Would require that *firearms dealers and other vendors of ammunition keep a registry of all buyers of handgun ammunition* and make it available to any law enforcement officer upon request.

Would further require that any person who *sells or transfers more than fifty rounds (one box) of handgun ammunition in a month obtain a handgun ammunition vendor's license* from the State Department of Justice. The Department would be required to maintain records of all ammunition vendors.

AB 962 would also *ban all mail order and internet sales of handgun ammunition and reloading components*. Location: Senate Floor; Position: *Opposed; Needed: contacts with members of the Senate*.
